Who?

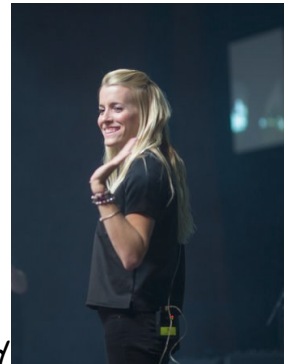
